Veteran's Village Affordable Green Housing Project Concept Overview

Mission: To create an ongoing program to fund and build healthy, safe, affordable housing for homeless / needy Veterans.

- 1. Partner with the Veterans Administration on excess and available ground on existing properties.
- 2. Raise private donations to fund the construction of homeless veteran housing
 - a. Private Investors
 - b. Corporations
 - c. GoFundMe campaign
 - d. Matching funds / grants from current VA programs. https://www.va.gov/homeless/
- 3. Create budget cost analysis model.
 - a. Secure-Lock structural system (Fire, Hurricane, Seismic, Pest, Mold-Resistant, Energy Efficient Structure):

- b. Transportation
- c. Slab Construction Labor Permits Finishes
- d. Furnishings from beds to silverware, including rocking chairs for the front porch
- e. Target an All-In price of \$150K per two person unit. \$3.0M = 20 homes = 40 Vets housed. Work with VA to design the buildings for optimum use of land.
- f. All products supplied to be screened for Sustainability by the non-profit Florida House Institute for Sustainable Development www.floridahouseinstitute.org A donation of 2% of the product costs to be donated to the nonprofit.
- 4. Hire Veterans to be trained on the Secure-Lock building the system for long term employment opportunities. Shell construction requires only simple carpentry skill.
- 5. Gift the houses to the VA for ownership, upkeep and control of who becomes a resident.
- 6. Criteria of a most affordable rent to the residents who will have a sense of responsibility.
 - a. Target \$200.00 per month per resident.

- 7. Create common area for barbeques, bocce ball and community activities.
